# READING

# READING

Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in this way. When his mother Mary had been betrothed to Joseph, before they came together she was found to be with child from the Holy Spirit. And her husband Joseph, being a just man and unwilling to put her to shame, resolved to divorce her quietly.FROM MATTHEW 1

Now the birth of Jesus Christ took place in a way that assures us that God is engaged with his broken people. The manner of Mary's pregnancy was shameful, and it is unlikely her proclaiming the angel's message would have brought anything but more shame. The genealogy that begins Matthew bears witness to this also, that God works in and through and near us, his broken people. He is Emmanuel, God with us.
